

Infant Classroom: Daily Care & Supply Guide for Parents

We want to make sure every infant has everything they need for a safe, comfortable, and successful day at school. Please review the following guidelines for bottles, breast milk, formula, clothing, and daily supplies.

Breast Milk & Bottles

1. For the safety and proper handling of breast milk, all breast milk must arrive already prepared in individual bottles with the amount your baby will need for each feeding.
2. Each bottle must be clearly labeled with your child's first and last name.
3. Breast milk must be provided in individual bottles and may not be brought in storage bags or other separate containers.
4. We are unable to transfer breast milk from a storage bag or separate container into bottles at school.
5. When you arrive in the morning, prepared bottles will be placed in the refrigerator and kept refrigerated until your baby's feeding time.
6. Infant bottles are heated using a bottle warmer when it is time for your baby to eat.
7. Please provide a minimum of 3 prepared bottles each day to ensure your baby has enough bottles available throughout the day.

Providing bottles that are ready to serve helps us maintain proper food-handling procedures while ensuring your baby's feedings are safe and on schedule.

Formula-Fed Infants

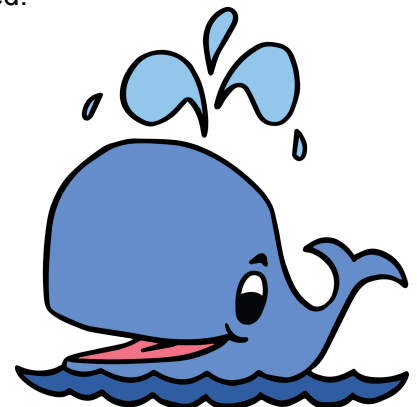
For babies who receive formula:

1. Water must be provided in individual bottles and prepared ahead of time.
2. Formula should either be pre-portioned for each bottle or a properly labeled container of formula may be brought in for preparation.
3. Please make sure all bottles and formula supplies are clearly labeled with your child's first and last name.
4. Our school provides two types of infant formula. If you would like your baby to use one of the formulas provided by the school, please contact the school office for more information.
5. Formula bottles are heated using a bottle warmer when needed.

Daily Clothing & Personal Items

Please keep the following items at school for your infant:

1. At least 2 complete changes of clothing
2. 1 crib sheet
3. 1 blanket
4. Diaper rash cream, if needed
5. Pacifier, if your baby uses one



6. 1 package of wipes
7. 1 package of diapers

Please label your child's personal belongings whenever possible.

Keeping Supplies Stocked

We will monitor your child's supplies and let you know when items are running low. When you receive a reminder, please bring in additional supplies as soon as possible so we can continue caring for your baby without interruption.
